Sarah Nerad serves as the Associate Director of Community Relations in Ohio for Alkermes, Inc. Prior to this, Sarah worked at The Ohio State University creating the Collegiate Recovery Community (CRC), a support program designed to help students in recovery. In Sarah's current unique role, she works with community leaders to promote practices and policies that advance systematic and lasting change to end the opioid epidemic.
